



Hand 'n Hand Exhibition

Thank you for teaching a *Hand 'n Hand* residency program. As stated in the grant, there will be an exhibition in a public space in the community showcasing:

- One piece of artwork from each student. (Do not include the *Yo Soy* artwork). If creating 3D artwork, check with the exhibition site to be sure they have enough pedestals.
Hint: If creating 2D artwork that will later be matted, create a ½" margin on their paper so their art will not be cropped.
- One collaborative piece created by the collaborative artist (the teaching artist with a disability), the teaching artist and the students in the residency.
- One piece of the teaching artist's artwork (optional).
- One piece of the collaborative artist's artwork (optional).

VSA Florida will provide your labels and mats (for 2D artwork). When requesting labels and mats:

- State the school name, county name, (artwork) size and quantity of mats.
- Submit your request to William Coleman, Director of Education, at least 15 business days prior to the installation of the exhibition at wpcoleman@usf.edu or 813-974-0735

Mat sizes available for the artwork are:

| Artwork Size | Outside Mat Size |
|--------------|------------------|
| 5" x 7" | 8" x 10" |
| 8" x 10" | 11" x 14" |
| 9" x 12" | 12" x 16" |
| 11" x 14" | 16" x 20" |
| 12" x 18" | 18" x 24" |

No specialty mat sizes will be provided.

Additional notes:

- Place the label on the bottom center of the mat and write the students' first names only.
- As per your Letter of Agreement, teaching artists may be responsible for: dropping off artwork at the exhibition site, installation of the exhibition, de-installation of the exhibition, and/or returning the individual artwork to students at the school. Please read your Letter of Agreement to see specific duties assigned to your program.
- It is encouraged that all students, classroom teachers, teaching artist, administrators, families and community members attend the reception.
