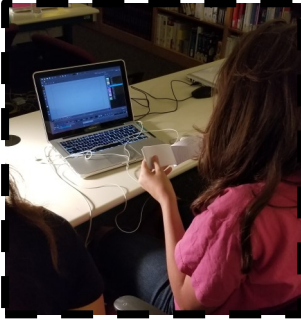


LET'S GET REAL

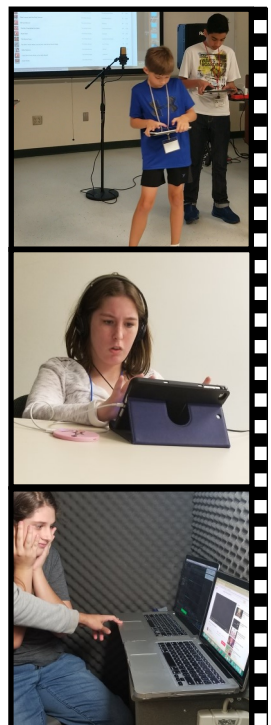
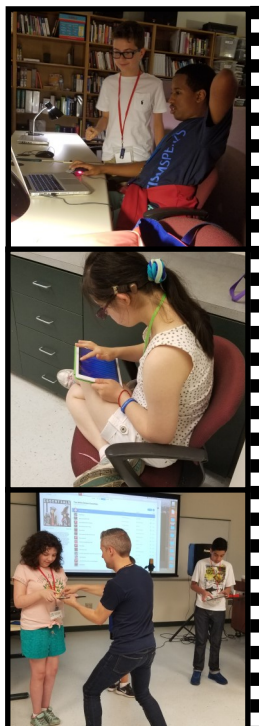
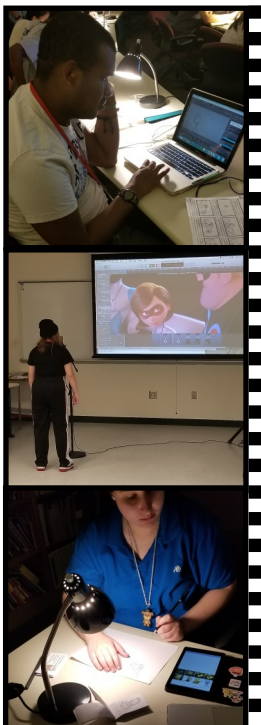


On Thursday, we spent our time making **original tracks** to put in a class playlist. Listening to our own creations is such an exciting feeling!
